VINTAGE: 1990

Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

Harvest dates: *(hand-picked)*

7 September – 9 September 1990 (3 days).

Grape varieties:

- 47% Viognier (origin of the vine: Georges Vernay – Condrieu).
- 26% Petit Manseng (origin of the vine: Charles Hours – Béarn).
- 16% Chardonnay.
- 11% rare grape varieties: Marsanne, Roussanne, Muscat Petit grain (France).

Climate:

Unusually hot weather even during winter.

A vine called 'Crespy' sprouted a new leaf on 20 January. Very hot weather from 1 May to September. Flowering started in mid-May.

Harvest: dry weather but with an east wind, cloudy, no sunshine.

Average age of the vines:

7 years.

Yield:

20 hl/ha.

Total production:

12.000 bottles.
