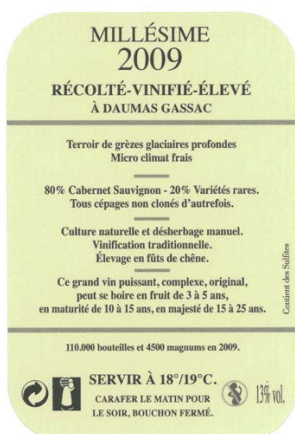


MAS DE DAUMAS GASSAC

VINTAGE: 2009

« A sumptuous vintage ! »

Denomination :

Vin de Pays de l'Hérault.

Harvest dates: (hand-picked)

10 September – 23 September 2009 (10 days).

Grape varieties :

- 72.4% Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 6.3% Merlot.
- 4.4% Cabernet Franc.
- 3.6% Tannat.
- 3.1% Pinot noir.
- 2.6% Malbec.
- 7.6% rare grape varieties: Petit Verdot, Abouriou (France), Nielluccio, Montepulciano (Italie), Saperavi (Géorgie), Carménère (France), Tempranillo (Espagne).

Climate:

Ideal spring with regular rainfall bringing enough reserve for the plants. The vigneron expected a late harvest mid-September, following a flowering around end of May.

Average age of the vines:

37 years.

35 to 45 hl/ha.

110.000 bottles and 4.500 magnums.
